



SunSafe Project

Curriculum: Grade 2



The students will:

- 1. Learn how too much sun is harmful to their skin.
- 2. Identify specific ways to protect themselves from too much sun.
- 3. Understand the importance of lifelong protection and how to maintain good habits.

Class One:

- I. Introduce the concept of skin and sun protection
 - discuss outdoor activities and the sun
 - discuss sunburns and how to prevent them
- II. Show Slip, Slop, Slap video (See Resource List.)
 - discuss different types of animals and how they protect themselves
 - discuss how the child in the video protects himself from too much sun
 - discuss harmful effects of too much sun on skin
- III. Give our parent-child home activity
 - magazine collage activity or activity of your choice

Class Two:

- I. Introduce the concept of habits
 - discuss what a habit is
 - brainstorm examples of healthy habits including sun protection
- II. Show Cover Up video (See Resource List.)
 - review important sun protection behaviors
- III. Review parent-child home activity
- IV. Present SunSafe certificate
