
How To Get Your Mammogram

If you have a doctor:

1. Call your doctor and ask for a mammogram.
 - Your doctor will tell you where to get a mammogram nearby.
 - You may also need to go to the doctor's office for a breast exam.
2. Go get the mammogram.
3. Get the results from your doctor.

If you do not have a doctor:

1. Call the Michigan Division of the American Cancer Society (800-227-2345). Tell them that you want a mammogram and don't have a doctor.
 - They will tell you about places near you that offer mammograms.
 - They can help you find a doctor in your community.
2. Call a mammogram facility or a doctor and ask for a mammogram.
 - If the facility does not have a doctor on site, they will help you find one.
 - The doctor will tell you where to get a mammogram. The doctor will probably want to see you to learn about your health.
3. Go get the mammogram.
4. Get the results from your doctor.
